THE MAKING OF A SYMPHONY

Within a symphony, there is a large and complex composition making up a full orchestra. Each individual playing their particular instruments whether stringed, brass or percussion is highly skilled and trained. Each one has a disciplined position creating harmony that blends in total synchronization. Nevertheless, it is the orchestra conductor who masterminds and orchestrates what and when they perform in precise conformity to tones and continuity. Each individual thus contributes wholeheartedly to the undertaking creating a musical crescendo worthy of a standing ovation in a display of team excellence. The amazing revelation created within a beautiful symphony is the fact that all are working together as “one” for a common goal of making the symphony performance its best.

THE EFFECTS OF THE SYMPHONY

The effects of a typical symphony is the harmony, the oneness that is created by all of the individuals working together. Although a symphony conductor will take a bow and receive applause from the audience for the performance, the conductor knows that without the musicians doing their part, there would be no performance to applaud.

THE SUPREME CONDUCTOR

The music on Earth, especially the symphony performance, mirrors the music in Heaven. The harmonious melody that echoes throughout Heaven is spoken of in (Revelation 5:9-10; Revelation 14: 2-3; Revelation 15:2-4) But, the music is not the only reflection of Heaven here on Earth. The work of the conductor is also mirrored in the person of the Holy Spirit.

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity (God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit). Many people can picture God the Father. They may think of Him as sitting on a throne. They may think He created heaven and Earth. People can usually picture Jesus. They have an idea that he came as a baby, lived as a carpenter, walked with the Apostles and did miracles. But who is the Holy Spirit? We often picture Him as a dove. But what He actually is like is a conductor of the people on earth. We are all together here, each with different talents and abilities. But, it is like we are on a stage. What we need to really LIVE life is the Conductor. He works in the background. You don't see Him on stage, but without His influence and guidance in our lives we might have music but will never reach the level of a symphony performance.

WHAT DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT DO ON EARTH?

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the triune Godhead He is the Supreme Conductor of God's will on earth. Jesus sent the Holy Spirit into the world after He rose from the dead and returned to Heaven and God the Father (Acts 1: 4-8). The Holy Spirit gives us the Power to be witnesses for Jesus. He gives us power to overcome issues in our lives. He gives us power to lay hands on people who are sick and they recover (Mark 16:16-18). When these things happen, we cannot take one ounce of credit because it is the work of God by the Holy Spirit through us (humans) one to another.

IF THE HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD, DO WE WORSHIP HIM?

The Holy Spirit, like any good conductor, takes no credit for Himself but rather exists to bring Glory and Honor to God the Father and Jesus. You don't worship the Holy Spirit, but it is important to acknowledge the role He plays in your life. Without turning to Him for guidance, you will not receive all that the Father has for you. By following the directions of the Supreme Conductor, the *music* of your life can be transformed into a *symphony performance*.
