GRACE: GOD'S PLAN



LIBERATION AT NORMANDY BEACH

When many people think about an example of liberation, they think of “D-Day” June 6, 1944 and the invasion of Normandy Beach with the liberation of France by Allied troops in World War II. The military assault included parachute and glider landings, air attacks on a massive scale, and naval battles. Amphibious landings occurred on 5 beaches. There would be no redemption or resurrection and no hope for us individually to receive everlasting life. No guarantee of this forgiveness and life with God. We can’t earn our way into heaven by doing good works, or by trying to be a holy man or woman in our own strength. The Blood of Jesus Christ shed on the Cross at Calvary, paid our sins in full. Nothing else is required.
